Resolutions of Executive Committee Meeting held in Professors' Common room of Jorhat Engineering College at 2:30 pm on 27<sup>th</sup> February 2020:

1. One minute silence was observed to mourn the unexpected death of Arup Kar, an active alumnus and a popular singer of Jorhat Engineering College. The members of JECAA prayed for eternal peace of the departed soul and prayed to the almighty to give strength to the bereaved family.

2. The new president Mr. Arindom Choudhury welcomes the members to the first executive committee meeting

3. Secretary Mr. Diganta Baishya informed that soft copy of List of Alumni upto 2005 entry batch is ready to be used. However the phone numbers and email Ids are to be collected in a systematic way to maintain privacy and security. Vice President Mr. Bikramaditya Das proposed to include Photograph in the database and the executive committee accepted the proposal.

4. Committee accepted proposal to reactivate the Alumni Chapters and open few new chapters. It is decided to open new chapters in Tezpur, Lakhimpur, Nagaon, Bongaigaon, Silchar, Manipur and Bangalore. Mr. Bharat Bhattacharya is entrusted with the responsibility to include Alumni from Tezpur, Mangaldai and Biswanath in Tezpur Chapter. The new chapter in Lakhimpur will include alumni from Lakhimpur and Dhemaji. The Nagaon chapter will include Alumni from Hojai, Koliabor and Karbi Anglong in addition to Nagaon.

5. Mr Sonit Bordoloi is requested to convene a meeting among Alumni from Jorhat to discuss the matter of opening a Jorhat Chapter. Mr Hemanta Madhab sarma and Mr. Mridu Mahendra Das are requested to take intuitive for Delhi and Bangalore Chapter. Mr Kumud hazarika and Mr. Anupam Bora are requested take initiative for Sibasagar chapter.

6. Executive Committee will try for online renewal of JECAA registration(pending after 2011) . However if any difficulty arises, Guwahati Chapter will assist in the process of offline registration.

7. Subject to approval of next AGM, it has been proposed to collect annual subscription of Rs 1000/- from already registered members and Rs 2000/- from new members.

8. Unique Membership Identification number will be provided to all registered Alumni

9. The proposed budget for developing Website is accepted.

10. JEC Authority is requested to take initiative for Gold Medal award (pending since 2012) to be awarded in Diamond Jubilee.

11. JEC Authority informed that Diamond Jubilee is proposed to be celebrated on 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> October 2020. The College Administration seeks support from JECAA to conduct the event. Principal, JEC informed that registration of participants will be done on first day of celebration. JECAA advised college authority to fix the Diamond Jubilee registration fee including the expenditure for Badge, Folder, and Souviner etc in registration fee. JECAA requests college administration to prepare a detailed list of events and budget for the celebration. Budgetary support for the event will be discussed in next meeting.

12. Following items are decided to be printed:

13. An amount of Rs 5,000/ ( Rs Five thousand only) is decided to be sanctioned to General Secretary for the interim expenditure. The amount will be recouped after submission of expenditure details to treasurer and subject to next executive body approval.

14. All members of "JEC Alumni Meet" are requested to post only JEC related matters.

15. The chapters are requested to open a whatsApp group within their chapters to discuss Alumni activities.

16. Central committee proposed to visit the chapters as and when required for revival of old chapters and opening of new chapters.

17. JEC authority is requested to allot a room for Alumni Association

18. The college authority said that they will organize a meeting next week and prepare a detailed budget for Diamond Jubilee Celebration.

19. The College main entrance gate up-gradation drawing was submitted by M/s Bajrang Fabricator. The members of the executive body had a discussion on the design and suggested to scrutinize the submitted drawing through competent authority of college for further action. The up gradation/ beautification cost of the gate shall be subject to fund availability or from sponsorship.
